Content:

- DG MARE is fully aware of the complexity of managing NQS
- crucial to improve the current knowledge and fill information / data gaps on brown crab stocks and fisheries, including through EU funded research projects
- Commission also encourages stakeholder initiatives to improve fisheries sustainability
- Commission supports proposals to evaluate and monitor the fishing effort and respective spatial-temporal distribution, as an approach to eventually limit the fishing effort through closures in the crab fishery
- Commission recognises the importance and usefulness of the harmonisation of some management measures, namely MCRS among Member States and ideally also with the UK
- reiterating my support to your initiatives aiming at improving the current information on this fishery and stock status
